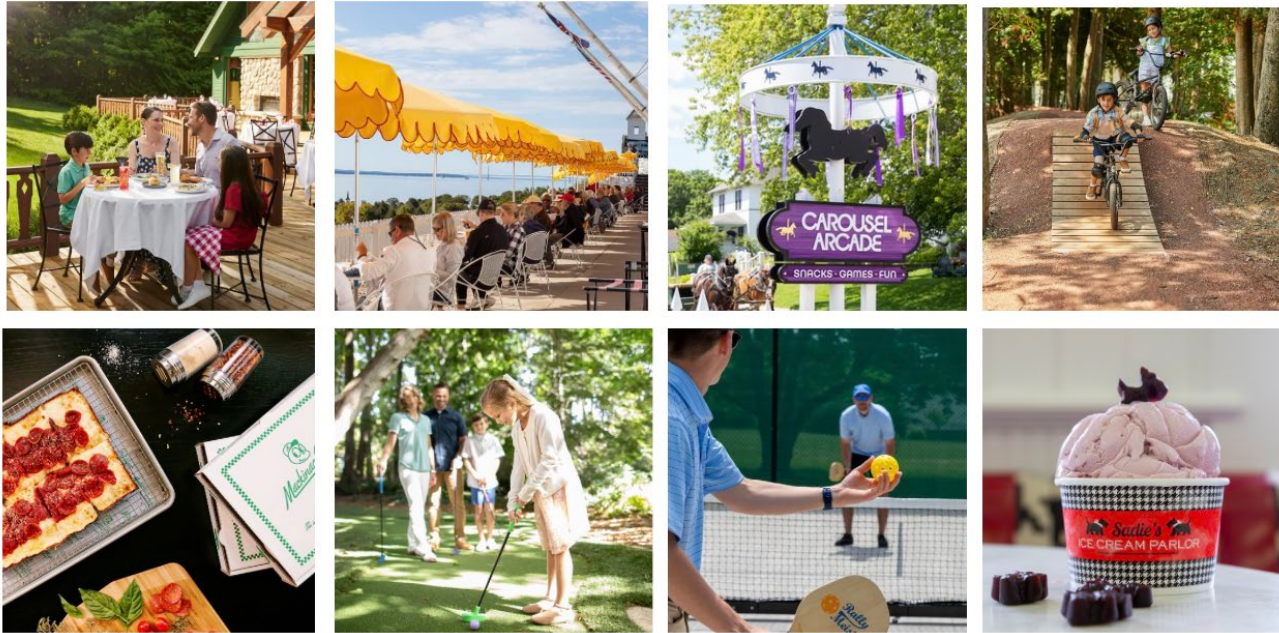

The M-185 Perimeter Tour



Bike the only highway in America where no cars are allowed

The M-185 Perimeter Tour is an eight-mile state highway that loops around Mackinac Island's shoreline. From start to finish, the flat, smooth asphalt road places you right between dramatic forestry and the rocky shores of Lake Huron with majestic views of their deep blue waters.

Experience the pristine air and tranquility of our island at your own pace, as you ride past incredible limestone formations, trickling island streams, and numerous historic points of interest.

Explore Mackinac Island

M-185 Perimeter Tour. You'll find lots of places to pull over and take a closer look at the natural beauty of Mackinac Island.

You'll be amazed at all there is to see as you ride past Fort Mackinac, Arch Rock, Point Aux Pins, British Landing, Lover's Leap, The Nature Center - and more!

Suitable for all ages and riding abilities, this adventurous perimeter tour (red route on the map) can be completed at a leisurely pace within 1.5 hours, including time for photos and restroom breaks along the way.

You'll enjoy the sense of accomplishment that comes with riding the entire loop. Riders keep track of their distance by following log mileage markers along the way.

Bring your camera and take plenty of photos to remind you of your visit here and to share with friends and family.

We are located on Main Street at Shepler's Ferry Dock. Look for our blue bike kiosks with our Start and Finish Lines.

No reservations necessary. Self-Guided Attraction Tours can be taken anytime of the day.

The Interior Island Tour



- 1. Arch Rock**
The steps lead you to the island's famous rock formation with one of the best views. Trust us, it's worth the climb!
- 2. Wild Flower Nature Trail**
Park your bike and take a hike on this wooden trail through tranquil wetlands.
- 3. British Landing**
Miles of pristine shoreline and the best view of the Mackinac Bridge.
- 4. Devil's Kitchen**
Steeped in Native American lore, this cave formation is one of the historic landmarks along M-185.
- 5. Downtown**
Fudge, dining, shopping, & more.
- 6. Leslie Avenue**
Beautiful paved rolling trail through the forest. Great for viewing wildlife and fall color.
- 7. Crack in the Island**
One of the most hidden gems of the island. You will park your bike at the airport and hike in about 50 yards. Check out the Cave in the Woods on your way.
- 8. Great Turtle Park**
Fun for the whole family! Disc golf (bring your own discs), playground, pickleball court, and a great place for a picnic.
- 9. Fort Holmes**
The highest point on the island, overlooking Fort Mackinac. Accessible up the stairs off Rifle Ridge Road.
- 10. Robinson's Folly**
Perched above East Bluff of Mackinac Island with great views of Round Island and the Straits of Mackinac.
